Notebook/Worksheet/Homework Submission

- Notebook/ Worksheet/Homework submission is a part of internal assessment; it is aimed at enhancing seriousness of students towards preparing notes for the topics being taught in the classroom as well as assignments.
- This also addresses the critical aspect of regularity, punctuality, neatness and notebook upkeep.
- All worksheets and Homework given on day-to-day basis will be assessed and marks will be added in the Assessment.

Subject Enrichment Activities/Projects

- These are subject specific application based activities aimed at enrichment of the understanding and skill development.
- These activities will be Academic based and Project based. All activities or projects will be assessed and marks will be added in the Assessment.

Note:

1. There will be two terms and four assessments.
2. Grading system of evaluation is followed for Grade I & II and marks will be reflected in the report cards for Grades III-V.
3. Every student must appear for all four assessments in each subject. However, if the child is sick, parents should not send the child to school even during the assessments. (Average marks will be awarded to those children after the submission of medical certificate.)
