

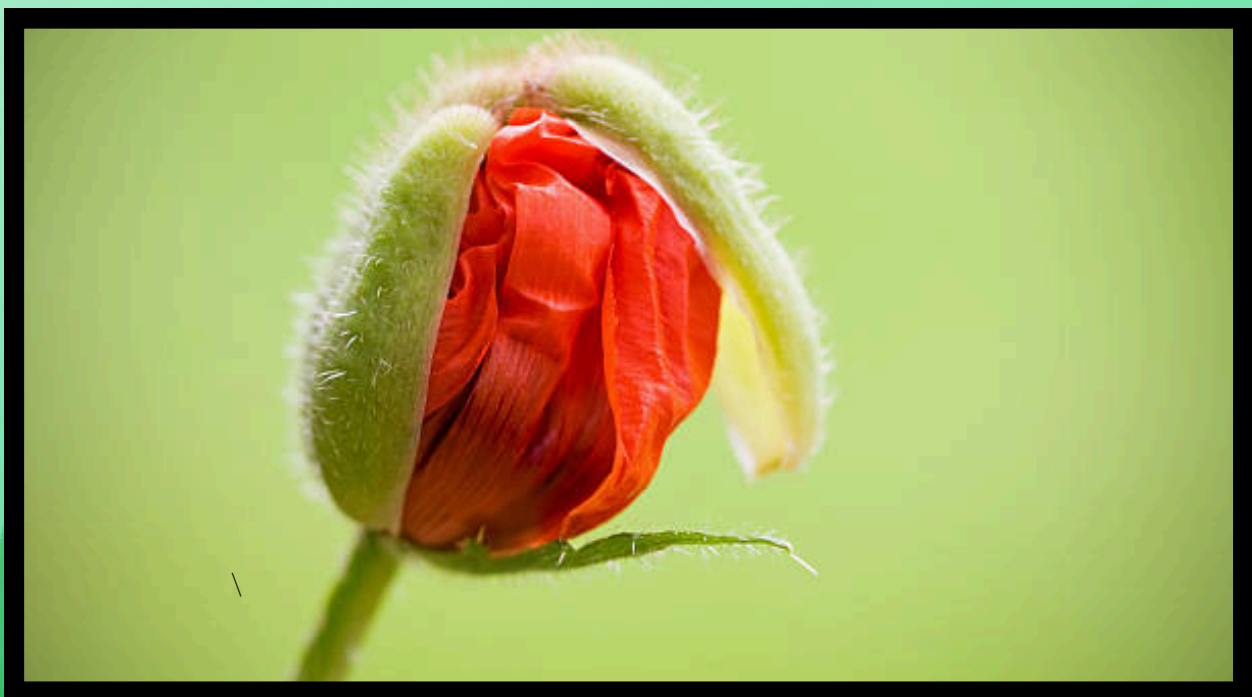

FROM THE GARDENER

महाभारत और दर्शन एक अध्यापिका की लेखनी से

महाभारत केवल एक महान महाकाव्य ही नहीं, बल्कि भारतीय जीवन-दर्शन का एक अमूल्य स्रोत भी है। यह ग्रंथ हमें जीवन के विविध आयामों-धर्म, कर्म, सत्य, कर्तव्य और नैतिकता-के बारे में गहराई से सोचने के लिए प्रेरित करता है। विद्यालयीन जीवन में जब हम विद्यार्थियों को सही दिशा देने की बात करते हैं, तब महाभारत के दर्शन का महत्व और भी बढ़ जाता है।

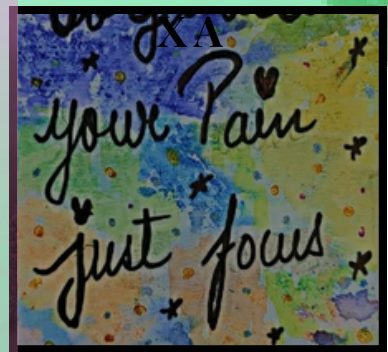
BUDDING VOICES
